- Background
- On November 18<sup>th</sup> CDC announced activation of the Public Health Crisis Response Cooperative Agreement
- Supports state and local public health MPOX prevention and response efforts
- For maintenance or expansion of activities to support outbreak response and integration of activities into sustainable programs to prevent future outbreaks
- Metro Health to continue prevention and response capacity by incorporating activities to routine practices in the STD Clinic



## Background

#### Case Counts:

- 30,061 in the US
- 2,895 in Texas
- 195 in Bexar County

#### Vaccinations to Date:

• 4,856 administered by Metro Health and partners





## **Fiscal Impact**



- Funding is made available from the CDC
- Acceptance of funds up to \$284,730.00
- Term: December 16, 2022 through December 15, 2023
- There is no impact to the general fund in the form of a cash match

### Recommendation



Staff recommends City Council approve the acceptance of funds from the CDC for the Public Health Crisis Response Cooperative Agreement: MPOX Response Funding
