# Board Purposes

- Provide oversight of the completion of streets, bridges, sidewalks, drainage and flood control bond program projects.
- Advise on how to improve outreach and communication efforts to residents and businesses affected by construction.
- Ensure transparent process in prioritizing undefined and future City street, bridge, sidewalk, drainage and flood control investments (project scoring criteria).

- 13 Members
- Two-year appointments, no term limits
- Meet monthly
