Program Intent

- Reduce military spouse unemployment rate
 - 20-35% nationally
- Connect employers to qualified military spouses

Overall Objective

- Improve Quality of Life
- Increase military retention rates
- Enhance military readiness
- Increase post-service retention in San Antonio

2019 - 2021 Pilot Program

\$150,000 - 2 -year agreement

- √40 Military Spouse participants
- ✓90% offered employment
- √60 host companies
- ✓ National Sponsorships
- √ Federal Recognition

Average Salary - \$61,000

Strategic Importance to the City of San Antonio

- Support of military families is criteria considered when the Department of Defense makes basing decisions (BRAC, Space Command, etc.)
- Hiring Our Heroes:
 - Highlights the City's tangible commitment to support the military
 - Highlights the City's willingness to invest public funds to support military families

FY23 Agreement

\$150,000 30 military spouses 1-year agreement

Local Program Manager:

- Advertises program
- Screens & advises applicants
- Sources potential host companies
 - Pairs spouse-host matches
- Provides CoSA with quarterly status updates

Military and Veteran Affairs Department:

- Monitors program and compliance
- Builds connections across industries
 - Advocates locally and nationally
