## Background



• In October of 2022, the grantor announced a contract extension to the grant and additional funds in the amount of 35% of the original award.

 Metro Health accepted the contract extension (May 1, 2022-June 30, 2023) and the additional award in the amount of \$26,250.00, for a total grant contract amount of \$101,250.0.00.

## Background



- 9,917 volunteers registered in the Texas Disaster Volunteer Registry (TDVR).
- Alamo Area MRC volunteers have provided well over 50,000 hours of volunteer service.
- Funding will be used provide trainings to Alamo Area Medical Reserve Corp members as needed to maintain volunteer readiness to respond for allhazards events.

## Fiscal Impact



- Funding is made available through NACCHO MRC COVID-19 RISE Grant
- Acceptance of funds up to \$26,250.00
- Term: May 1, 2022-June 30, 2023
- There is no impact to the general fund in the form of a cash match.
