

**RFCA #23-190269**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee, or the San Antonio Chief of Police or designee, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application, and accept grant funds upon award in an amount up to \$2,178,947.00 from the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) for the 2023 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) grant for the period beginning January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2024. A copy of said application is on file with the San Antonio Police Department.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or designee, or the San Antonio Chief of Police or designee, is hereby further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance, and amendments which will provide supplemental grant funds to the grant by the funding agency in an amount up to 20% of the total amount initially awarded to the grant, with no cash match or personnel complement changes.

**SECTION 3.** Upon acceptance of this ordinance, new funds and Internal Orders will be created for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant and a sum not to exceed \$2,178,947.00 will be appropriated in said funds. The budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

**SECTION 4.** A personnel complement of seventeen (17) positions, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I, is approved.

**SECTION 5.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
