ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A NASA @ MY LIBRARY GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS, UPON AWARD, OF UP \$25,000 FROM THE SPACE SCIENCE INSTITUTE THROUGH THE PERIOD OF NOVEMBER 30, 2025.

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WHEREAS, in 2017, Space Science Institute (SSI) reached approximately 1.75 million people through 7,000 public libraries with 2.1 million eclipse glasses, programming, and subject matter expert support; and

WHEREAS, Science Mission Directorate (SMD) was instrumental to this program, providing access to subject matter experts, access to community partnership opportunities, and enhancing training activities for library staff to include vetted NASA content; and

WHEREAS, with a new, expanded grant from Moore, the SSI team is currently distributing eclipse glasses to libraries and providing in-person training through state library agencies in each US state and territory; and

WHEREAS, the proposed NASA @ My Library augmentation is a low cost, low risk, and high impact opportunity that will inject NASA science into those interactions, and make sure they are available to Spanish speaking families; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Public Library or designee, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application and accept grant funds, in an amount of \$25,000.00 from the Space Science Institute through the period of November 30, 2025.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Public Library or designee, is further authorized to execute any, and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 3 Should funding be awarded, upon acceptance of this award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount of \$25,000.00 will be appropriated in said funds. A final budget, including Internal Orders and GL Accounts, will be submitted by the San Antonio Public Library upon award.

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SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
