

ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2023 FIESTA SAN ANTONIO CELEBRATION; APPROVING THE DATES, TIMES AND LOCATIONS FOR THE FIESTA CARNIVAL AND OFFICIAL FIESTA EVENTS, AND RELATED REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS; APPROVING THE FIESTA PARADE ROUTES.

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WHEREAS, San Antonio’s annual Fiesta San Antonio Celebration, through the dedicated efforts of many civic-minded persons and nonprofit organizations, has achieved statewide, national, and international recognition as one of the outstanding festival events in our nation; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2018-12-13-1019 of December 13, 2018, set the dates for Fiesta San Antonio for the years 2019 through 2028, designated the Fiesta San Antonio Commission as the planning and coordinating organization for the event, provided for and allocated financial support to Fiesta events, and made other provisions in connection with Fiesta; and

WHEREAS, planning is underway for the 2023 Fiesta San Antonio, and it is necessary to approve certain events, close streets to vehicular traffic in connection with certain events, approve the dates, times and locations for events, including the Fiesta Carnival, and declaring the rules, rates, regulations and conditions for staging these events; and also to approve the Fiesta Parade Routes and close streets to vehicular traffic in connection with the Fiesta Parades; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. In support of an initiative by the Texas Department of Transportation to inform and protect the interests of the citizens of San Antonio, all Fiesta San Antonio Commission participating member organizations are encouraged to place the slogan “Fiesta Safe, Drive Sober” on cups and other collateral material distributed during the 2023 Fiesta San Antonio. This is the 25th year the Texas Department of Transportation has sponsored this public information campaign highlighting the need to actively promote and provide public notice to celebrate responsibly during Fiesta 2023.

SECTION 2. The following Fiesta events are approved for the dates and times as set forth below. The listed public streets and right-of-ways shall be closed to vehicular traffic during the dates and times indicated to facilitate the events and their use of the public property. For the events listed in this section, no carnivals or games are permitted on public right-of-way. Additionally, other than City-approved contractors, no use, including but not limited to, amplification and public demonstrations, will be allowed in public right-of-ways in and around the Carnival and Alamodome area. At any time the City’s right-of-ways are closed or partially closed, all Official Fiesta Events are obligated to adhere to the City’s latest barricade standards and specifications.

1. FIESTA-FIESTA OPENING CEREMONY: BLOCK PARTY PERMIT REQUIRED

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 19, 2023 7:00 p.m. UNTIL FRIDAY, APRIL 21, 2023 6:00 a.m.

Navarro Street between Travis Street and Pecan Street

Pecan Street between Navarro Street and Broadway Street

Jefferson Street between Travis Street and Martin Street

Parking Restrictions: The south curb lane of Martin Street between Taylor Street and Navarro Street and south curb lane of Pecan Street from Jefferson Motor Bank Driveway to Navarro Street. In addition, the east bound, south curb lane of Travis from Jefferson to Broadway will be restricted for City Service Vehicles.

Event Date & Times: **Thursday, April 20, 2023 4:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.**

2. UTSA FIESTA ARTS FAIR:

FRIDAY, APRIL 21, 2023 8:00 a.m. thru 6:00 p.m. and

SUNDAY, APRIL 23, 2023 6:00 p.m. thru 10:00 p.m.

Augusta between Navarro and Giraud closed to through traffic.

Augusta between Giraud and Convent open to **one-way** traffic **southbound** to allow parking on the east side of Augusta.

Police officers stationed at all times at Augusta & Giraud, Augusta & Convent, and Augusta & Navarro.

SATURDAY, APRIL 22, 2023 7:00 a.m. thru SUNDAY, APRIL 23, 2023 6:00 p.m.

Augusta between Navarro and Giraud closed to through traffic.

Augusta between Giraud and Convent open to **two-way** traffic.

Police officers stationed at all times at Augusta & Navarro and at Augusta & Giraud.

Off-duty officers will be required to direct vehicular and pedestrian traffic and must be at their posted locations throughout the entire duration of the requested street closures. The daily placement and daily removal of all traffic control devices shall only be done by the certified barricade company, at the expense of the event sponsor. Augusta Street between Convent and Navarro shall be open to two-way traffic during non-event hours.

Event Dates & Times: **Saturday, April 22, 2023 10 a.m. until 6 p.m.**

Sunday, April 23, 2023 11 a.m. until 5 p.m.

3. NIGHT IN OLD SAN ANTONIO:

Presa St. The following streets will be closed beginning Saturday, April 22, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 30, 2023; Presa Street between Market Street and Nueva Street.

Presa Street between Nueva St. and Arciniega St will be made a one-way southbound during event hours only (4:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m. (midnight) April 25, 2023 through April 28, 2023).

Alamo St. Southbound Alamo between Villita and Nueva Street will be closed beginning Saturday, April 22, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Saturday, April 29, 2023; Northbound Alamo east curb lane between Villita and Market Street may be closed and used as an expanded sidewalk on event days from 3:00 p.m. to midnight at the discretion of SAPD. The northbound and southbound lanes of Alamo St. between Market and Villita will remain open to thru traffic for Hilton Hotel access.

The northbound lanes of Alamo St. between Cesar Chavez and Market may be closed to thru traffic on event days from 3:00 p.m. until 12:00 p.m. (midnight) at the discretion of SAPD while ensuring access for construction project vehicles. Parking passes, if available due to construction, for the northbound, east curb lane between Cesar Chavez Street and Nueva Street can be obtained from SAPD Traffic.

Nueva St. The following streets will be closed beginning Saturday, April 22, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 30, 2023: the median and west bound lanes of Nueva Street between Alamo Street and 235 feet west of Presa Street (Thai Lucky building) . The inside eastbound lane of Nueva may be closed between Presa St. to and 107 feet east of St. Mary's St., Tuesday, April 25, 2023 thru Friday, April 28, 2022 from the hours of 4 p.m. until midnight at the discretion of SAPD. The south curb, eastbound lane of Nueva will be available for vehicular access to the Fairmount Hotel and St. John's Lutheran Church.

Market St. VIA will use the south curb lane of Market Street between Alamo and Convention Way to drop off Park-n-Ride riders. VIA will provide their own security for their buses and drop off area.

River Walk Areas: NIOSA is approved to expand the controlled area during event hours only (4:30 p.m. until 10:30 p.m. April 25, 2023 through April 28, 2023). NIOSA may also erect two (2) gate locations beginning at 4:30 p.m. until 10:30 p.m. each event night along the south bank of the river walk at (1) the Hilton/Little Rhein Prost Haus sidewalk landing, and (2) at a point approximately fifty (50) feet west of the Arneson River Theater Iron Gate, also on the south bank of the San Antonio river.

Event Dates & Times: **Tuesday, April 25 thru Friday, April 28, 2023; 5 p.m. until 10 p.m. each day**

Construction Impact: If ongoing construction negatively impacts the footprint of NIOSA, CITY, acting through Director of the Center City Development and Operations Department or designee reserves the right to work with organizers to adjust footprint as needed.

4. FIESTA DE LOS REYES AT MARKET SQUARE:

Fiesta De Los Reyes at Market Square Approved Event Hours of Operation (Reference City Ordinance 2019-01-31-0105):

April 21-30, 2023 - 10:00 a.m. until 12:00 a.m. midnight daily (with the exceptions of Saturday, April 22 & 29, time is extended until 1:00 a.m.)

San Saba St. Beginning at 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, until 5:00 p.m. on Monday May 1, 2023 San Saba St. between Dolorosa and W. Commerce St. will be closed entirely, to include sidewalks and roadway. The east and west curb lanes of San Saba between Commerce and Houston Street will also be closed. During the closure of San Saba St. between Dolorosa and W. Commerce St., a certified peace officer will be required to man the traffic barricades during the following dates and times:

Friday, April 21, 2023 until Sunday, April 30, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m., each day
Monday, May 1, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

The parking meters on the west curb lane of San Saba north of Houston to before the parking lot entrance will be restricted from 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, until 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on Thursday, April 27, 2023.

San Saba between Commerce and Houston may be closed at the discretion of SAPD during event days and the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m. on weekends and from 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on weekdays. In addition, the west bound lane of Commerce between Santa Rosa and Pecos may be closed during these times at the discretion of SAPD.

Santa Rosa St. Beginning at 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Wednesday, April 19, 2023, until 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Monday, May 1, 2023 The southbound west curb lane of Santa Rosa from Commerce to Dolorosa will be closed. A lane and a half will be provided at the point where there are four southbound lanes on Santa Rosa between Commerce and Dolorosa.

Santa Rosa St. Center Median: A fence, at the expense of the event, which is a minimum height of 6' will be erected to prevent pedestrians from crossing Santa Rosa mid-block between Commerce and Dolorosa.

NO SIDEWALKS OR TRAFFIC LANES SHALL BE CLOSED AT ANY OTHER PERIOD OTHER THAN THE DATE AND TIME INDICATED BY THIS ORDINANCE.

Pecos Street: The area from the "Tour Bus Loading Zone" to the temporary fence erected under IH-35 ramp shall be used for parking by permit only as issued by the City of San Antonio Public Works Department Engineering Division, for Market Square vehicles relating to the Fiesta De Los Reyes at Market Square event. A band stage and a large trailer for the speaker system can be provided, but the semi-tractor rig and other associated non-conforming vehicles must be elsewhere. Parking on City sidewalks and Gateway Plaza and other Plaza pedestrian walkways **WILL NOT BE AUTHORIZED AND STRICTLY ENFORCED BY SAPD AND CENTER CITY DEVELOPMENT & OPERATIONS PARKING ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL.**

Approved Vendor Service Vehicle Parking: Commercial vendor's service vehicles with a paid valid affixed commercial placard and displayed valid parking permit (parking meter bag) issued by the City of San Antonio (Public Works Department Traffic Engineering) will be authorized to park at the following locations:

On the south bound, west curb lane of Santa Rosa between Commerce and Dolorosa.

On the west bound, south curb lane of W. Commerce between Pecos and Leona Streets, if available due to current construction.

On the west and east curb lanes of San Saba between Commerce and Houston.

On the west curb lane (bagged meters) of San Saba just north of Houston until the entrance of the parking lot.

On the north curb lane of Dolorosa from Pecos to before parking lot ramp.

On north side of Dolorosa between San Saba and Santa Rosa (1 trailer and 2 trucks) between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on weekdays and 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. on weekends, if available due to any construction. The serving, loading and/or unloading of any parked trailers on Dolorosa Street during event operations will be hereby prohibited and violators will be towed at owner's expense.

The parking on the south side of Dolorosa St. shall be restricted between San Saba and Santa Rosa streets and used for emergency vehicles only. Strict enforcement will begin at 3:00 p.m. on weekdays and 9:00 a.m. on weekends. **Absolutely no beer trucks or trailers will be permitted to park on the south curb of Dolorosa at any time.** Any item put on the street that is not considered a motor

vehicle must be approved by SAPD, Center City Development, and PWD Traffic Engineering. Proper barricading must be afforded any item placed on the street using the TMUTCD as a guide.

Construction Impact: If ongoing construction negatively impacts the footprint of Fiesta De Los Reyes, CITY, acting through Director of the Center City Development and Operations Department or designee reserves the right to work with organizers to adjust footprint as needed.

Minimum Annual Guarantee Adjustment: If activity, including but not limited to construction or a change in schedule, results in a negative impact to the footprint or capacity of Fiesta De Los Reyes, CITY, acting through Director of the Center City Development and Operations Department or designee, reserves the right to adjust the minimum annual guarantee with reasonable notice to organizers.

5. **ST. MARY'S OYSTER BAKE:**

The following streets shall be closed on Friday, April 21, 2023 from 3:30 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. and on Saturday, April 22, 2023 from 9:30 a.m. until 11:00 p.m.

- Marquette Street between 36th Street and Camino Santa Maria
- Overhill Street between 36th Street and Camino Santa Maria
- Camino Santa Maria between Colgate and Wake Forest (westside curb only for VIA bus parking, twelve foot (12') width, from face of curb)
- Overhill, between Hillcrest and 36th Street
- Marquette, between Hillcrest and 36th Street
- Riverdale, between Hillcrest and 36th Street
- Bangor, between Hillcrest and 36th Street
- Globe, between Hillcrest and 36th Street
- Continental, between Hillcrest and 36th Street
- Lark, between Hillcrest and 36th Street
- Brandywine, between Hillcrest and 36th Street
- Belfair between Woodlawn Ave. and Overhill Dr.
- Overhill Drive between Camino Santa Maria St. and Duke Ave.
- Marquette Dr. between Camino Santa Maria St. and Duke Ave.
- Wake Forrest Dr. between Camino Santa Maria St. and Stone Gate
- Fordham Ave. between Camino Santa Maria St. and Notre Dame Dr.
- Norte Dame Dr. between Overhill Dr. and Stone Gate

All traffic control devices will be the responsibility of St. Mary's University.

6. **PILGRIMAGE TO THE ALAMO: PROCESSION PERMIT REQUIRED.** Route starts at Auditorium Circle, south on Jefferson, East on Houston to Alamo Plaza. Parking will be restricted or prohibited on Jefferson Street from Auditorium Circle to Houston Street on Monday, April 24, 2023. The streets will be closed on Monday, April 24, 2023 from 3:00 p.m. until 5:30 p.m.

7. **PARADES: BATTLE OF FLOWERS AND FIESTA FLAMBEAU:**

PROCESSION PERMIT REQUIRED. Both parades will follow this route: assemble at Locust and N Main Ave, south on Main, continue south on Lexington, north on St. Mary's Street, east on Brooklyn Ave, south on Avenue E, west on Houston St, south on Alamo, west on Commerce, north on Santa Rosa, disband at Santa Rosa and Martin Street. Camden from Richmond and Lexington will

be closed Friday, April 28, 2023 from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. and on Saturday, April 29, 2023 from 12:00 p.m. (noon) until 12:00 a.m. (midnight). Parking restrictions should be placed on the north and south curb meters from Thursday, April 27, 2023 until Sunday, April 30, 2023.

Parking Restrictions:

Dallas between Richmond and Lexington (north curb lane) meter restrictions from Thursday, April 27, 2023 at 6:00 a.m. until Sunday, April 30, 2023 at 6:00 a.m.

Camden between Lexington and Baltimore (south curb lane) meter restrictions from Thursday, April 27, 2023 at 6:00 a.m. until Sunday, April 30, 2023 at 6:00 a.m.

Houston between Santa Rosa and San Saba (north and south curb lane) meter restrictions from Thursday, April 27, 2023 at 6:00 a.m. until Sunday, April 30, 2023 at 6:00 a.m.

San Saba between Houston and Martin to include any meters and Commercial Loading Zones (CLZs) from Friday, April 28, 2023 at 12:00 a.m. until Sunday, April 30, 2023 at 6:00 a.m.

Forming Area: Access to forming area shall be limited to parade participants, parade organizers, residents and business employees living or working within the formation area and emergency personnel – This includes **both** vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

- Main Ave between Ashby Pl and Myrtle St
- Howard St. between Ashby Pl and Dewey Pl
- Lewis St between Ashby Pl and Dewey Pl
- Belknap Pl between Ashby Pl and Dewey Pl
- Courtland Pl between San Pedro Ave and Main Ave
- Dewey Pl between San Pedro Ave and Main Ave
- Howard St between Evergreen and north of Park Ave
- Locust St between Main and San Antonio College private drive
- Myrtle St between Main and San Antonio College private drive

Disbanding Area: Access to the Disbanding area shall be limited to parade participants, parade organizers, residents and business employees living or working within the disbanding area and emergency personnel – This includes **both** vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

- Martin between IH-35 and Flores Street
- Cameron between IH 35 and Travis Streets
- Salinas between Flores and Cameron Streets
- San Saba between Houston and Martin Streets
- Santa Rosa between Martin and San Saba Streets
- Columbus between Martin and Cameron Streets
- Kingsbury between Cameron and Flores Streets
- Quincy between Martin and Cameron Streets

Forming and Disbanding Area access restrictions for the Battle of Flowers parade begins at 5:00 a.m. and ends at the conclusion of the parade on Friday, April 28, 2023. Access restrictions for the Fiesta Flambeau parade begin at 3:30 p.m. and ends at the conclusion of the parade on Saturday, April 29, 2023.

No parade street chair vendors, chair suppliers or individuals will be allowed to place or store Parade Street Chairs on the City's right of way (City sidewalks) on or before Thursday, April 27, 2023 at 3:00 p.m. The San Antonio Police Department will be enforcing this restriction. Any chairs placed or stored earlier than these specified times will be subject to impoundment.

The public streets and right-of-ways indicated on the 2023 Fiesta Parade Route shall be closed to vehicular traffic during the aforementioned dates, at times specified by the Chief of Police, to facilitate the event and its use of the public property. The San Antonio Police Department will coordinate bus detour routes with VIA to use during the parades if necessary. Public Works Department shall put in place any temporary traffic signs to facilitate necessary bus detours. Once the parade route is closed and it has been deemed safe by the Chief of Police, or his designee, chairs will be allowed in the roadway. Generally, street chairs can be placed for parade viewing from 7:30 a.m. on Friday, April 28, 2023 until the conclusion of the Battle of Flowers parade, and from 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 29, 2023 until the conclusion of the Fiesta Flambeau Parade. **No street chair sections will obstruct cross walks. Santa Rosa from Commerce to Martin, and the City's right of way (excluding designated fire lane intersections), including all sidewalks has been designated as a Free Zone for parade viewing. No individuals will be permitted to sell seating in these areas.**

Participates and spectators shall be bound by Article XVII Section 19-638 (Public Conduct During Parades)

On January 19, 2012, the City Council authorized prohibiting smoking within the public right of way, and in any seats within the public right of way or on city property, along the Texas Cavaliers' River Parade, the Fiesta Battle of Flowers Parade, and the Fiesta Flambeau Parade routes. The City has coordinated with the Fiesta Commission on public outreach efforts. In addition, Solid Waste Management Department staff is working with the Fiesta Commission's Fiesta Verde Committee to improve trash collection and recycling efforts along the parade routes.

8. KING WILLIAM FAIR: BLOCK PARTY PERMIT REQUIRED

A 20-foot fire lane will be maintained on all closed streets. By 12:00 P.M. (noon) on Thursday, April 27, 2023, "no parking" signs will be installed on those streets to be closed that are north and west of Alamo Street. The following streets will be closed to thru traffic at 6:00 a.m. on Friday, April 28, 2023, until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 29, 2023.

East Guenther between South Alamo and South Main
King William between East Guenther and South St. Mary's
Madison between East Guenther and South St. Mary's
Washington between Arsenal and Turner
East Johnson between the San Antonio River and South Alamo
West Johnson between San Antonio River and City Street (barricade at south side of City St)
East Sheridan between the San Antonio River and South Alamo
Beauregard between Washington and South Alamo
Turner between Washington and South Alamo
Pancoast between Washington and Cesar Chavez
Arsenal between South Main Street and Washington
City between West Sheridan and Arsenal

Any item put on the street that is not considered a motor vehicle must be approved by SAPD, Center City Development, and PWD Traffic Engineering. Proper barricading must be afforded any item placed on the street using the TMUTCD as a guide.

The following streets will be closed to thru traffic from 6:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon (or until the conclusion of the King William Fair parade) on Saturday, April 29, 2023: **PROCESSION PERMIT REQUIRED.**

By Friday night, April 28, 2023, "no parking" signs will be installed on those streets south and east of Alamo Street and east of the San Antonio River that will have limited parking effective the following day. In addition to the 100 block of Mission Street, which currently prohibits parking on both sides of the street; parking on both sides of the 100 block of Wickes and the 100 block of Adams will be prohibited on Saturday, April 29, 2023. Parking on the following streets will be permitted on the west (river) side of the street on Saturday, April 29, 2023 (meaning that "no parking" signs will be installed on the east (non-river) side of the streets):

No carnival rides or games shall be located on Main Ave. or within Main Plaza Park or other public rights of way. Any item put on the street that is not considered a motor vehicle must be approved by SAPD, Center City Development, and TCI Traffic Engineering Division. Proper barricading must be afforded any item placed on the street using the TMUTCD as a guide.

10. THE DECO DISTRICT ARTS AND MUSIC FESTIVAL: BLOCK PARTY PERMIT REQUIRED:

Event will be held at Woodlawn Lake Park on Saturday, April 22, 2023. “No Parking Signs” shall be placed on the following streets:

- Cincinnati Ave between Josephine Tobin Dr and Goodrich Ave
- Goodrich Ave between Texas Ave and Cincinnati Ave
- Texas Ave between Adaes Ave and Goodrich Ave
- Adaes Ave between Texas Ave and Josephine Tobin Dr

SECTION 3. The 2023 Carnival shall conform to the following schedule and requirements. The Fiesta Commission must enforce these schedules and requirements through its contract for the carnival concession. A copy of the approved Carnival layout is attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Attachment 1.**

1. The approved hours of operation are as follows. These hours are subject to modification through approval of the City Manager or designee.

2. Alamodome: The Carnival Site is located in the parking lots of the Alamodome owned and operated by the City. To avoid conflicts, City and Alamodome staff shall work cooperatively with the carnival contractor to ensure carnival operations.

The Commission, it’s sub licensees, and any Fiesta event must honor and utilize all vendors with which the City has an exclusive contract for the Alamodome, including, but not limited to,

catering, concessions, telephone, ticket sales and electrical work to the extent such exclusive contracts control venue used by the Commission or its assignees.

The plan for placement of carnival booths, stands, and carnival rides must be received by the Center City Development & Operations Office by Friday, March 31, 2023. The plan must have approval of the Police Department. The Police shall be provided Police Command Posts at the carnival location as requested by the Police Department and include utility services as necessary.

3. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide sight triangles at street intersections that are not closed to traffic according to City standards.
4. The Carnival Concessionaire shall maintain chemical toilets with large banners above the area and security lighting. The location and number of toilets shall be as required by the Director of Health. All chemical toilets shall be serviced a minimum of every four hours during the hours that the carnival is open to the public and once after the carnival closes. If a chemical toilet overflows, the area shall be cleaned immediately.
5. The Carnival Concessionaire shall use a barricade company approved by the City to provide the traffic control devices needed to properly barricade the carnival both during operating and non-operating hours. The Carnival Concessionaire must adhere to the traffic notes in the Annual Fiesta Ordinance plus the traffic notes and details on the existing traffic control plan.
6. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide and pay for supplementary twenty-four (24) hour security (City of San Antonio Police Officers) as determined necessary by the City.
7. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide and pay for one (1) on call fire inspector for the carnival site from one (1) hour prior to the carnival beginning to carnival closing, each day from April 20, 2023 until April 30, 2023. The fire inspector shall be paid at the rate of time consistent with the Fire Collective Bargaining Agreement. All such City documented inspection costs shall be paid in full to the City of San Antonio no later than seven (7) days after receipt of the final invoices from the Fire Department.
8. The Carnival Concessionaire agrees to comply with all other conditions set by the City Manager's Office necessary to ensure the public health, safety, and welfare.
9. All sidewalks located next to or in the carnival area must remain open to full width during non-carnival operating hours. No encroaching of any sort will be allowed during non-carnival operating hours.
10. The Carnival Concessionaire agrees to comply with all City, State and Federal laws, statutes and ordinances for the operation of this event. This includes, but is not limited to, the application and payment of all licenses and permits required for the inspection and operation of rides, equipment, food, drink, and novelty booths.
11. Beverage Container Regulations:
 - (a) *Prohibited.* It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly possess a beverage in the area of the Fiesta Carnival, Market Square and La Villita unless such beverage is in a plastic, paper or aluminum container. For purposes of this section, the contents of the container, other than paper or plastic, shall be presumed to be the beverage its' label indicates. No ice chests will be allowed in any of the above mentioned areas.

- (b) *Exceptions.* The provisions of this section shall not apply to restaurants or other establishments located in the area of the Fiesta Carnival, Market Square and La Villita where beverages in bottles, cans or glasses are served in the regular course of business; however, possession of beverages in such containers shall be restricted to the immediate area of the establishment's leased premises. This year in 2023, granting an exception to the Municipal Code and the Fiesta Commission contract, all Fiesta events shall be granted an exception and vendors allowed the possession and sale of aluminum bottles.
- (c) *Penalty.* Any person violating the terms of this section shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

SECTION 4. The parade route, as **Attachment 2**, for the 2023 Fiesta Parades: the Battle of Flowers, and the Fiesta Flambeau, scheduled for Friday, April 28, 2023 and Saturday, April 29, 2023 is hereby approved. The public streets and right-of-ways indicated on the 2023 Fiesta Parade Route shall be closed to vehicular traffic during the aforementioned dates, at times specified by the Chief of Police, to facilitate the event and its use of the public property. A copy of the approved parade food and beverage booth locations is hereby approved in **Attachment 3**. It is the responsibility of the Fiesta San Antonio Commission to ensure the concessionaire abides by all requirements related to food and beverage booths/stands/trucks as listed in the attachment.

SECTION 5. Bleacher placement along the parade route, in accordance with the diagram is attached hereto as **Attachment 4** and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes, is hereby approved. Any changes in bleacher placement due to construction or any unforeseen circumstance must be communicated to the Center City Development & Operations Office prior April 20, 2023. The agreement with the U.S. General Services Administration permitting placement of bleachers along the east side of the Federal Building on Alamo Plaza without blocking the letter collection boxes, if applicable, and any entrances on the east side of the Federal Building must be received by Center City Development & Operations Office by March 31, 2023. The application is attached hereto as **Attachment 5** and incorporated by reference herein for all purposes.

SECTION 6. The Fiesta San Antonio Commission agrees to place chemical toilets at designated locations for parade days of April 24, 28 and 29, 2023, listed attached hereto as **Attachment 6**. Fiesta Commission agrees to ensure all chemical toilets are secured during non-event hours.

SECTION 7. Sunken Garden Theater Fiesta 2023 Rental Rates. The San Antonio Zulu Association is hereby granted the use of the Sunken Garden Theater as an official Fiesta event on the following dates and the listed rental rates. This organization shall also be required to use the SAWS parking garage and shall reimburse the City for the actual costs for administration, insurance, security and site cleanup for each event date. The organization shall also comply with the attendance limits of not more than 6,000 persons at any one time and sound level limits as approved and applicable to the Sunken Garden Theater. Set up shall take place Monday, April 17 through Thursday, April 20, 2023 and take down shall take place on Monday, April 24, 2023.

Note: These rates are in addition to the rates and requirements established in the Short Term License Agreement for the use of Sunken Garden Theater.

SECTION 8. The City Manager, the Chief of Police, or their respective designees, are hereby authorized to execute a contract, in substantially same form as set forth in the Texas Education Code, Sec. 37.081 © and (g), with public school districts to employ peace officers commissioned by those school districts who are licensed by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement. These officers may work as peace officers under the supervision of the San Antonio Police Department within the boundaries of the City of San Antonio during Fiesta, parades, runs and races, and other public events on an as needed basis at the standard rate paid to peace officers from other outside police agencies, as set forth in the contract.

SECTION 9. Except for changes made in this Ordinance, the 2023 Fiesta San Antonio celebration shall be conducted in accordance with Ordinance No. 2018-12-13-1019 of December 13, 2018. All terms, conditions, requirements, and restrictions contained within the Fiesta San Antonio Commission Contract shall continue to govern the Fiesta and all Fiesta events unless specifically amended or rescinded herein.

SECTION 10. A violation of any provision of this Ordinance or Ordinance No. 2018-12-13-1019 shall be punished by a fine not exceeding two hundred dollars (\$200.00). Each day's violation of any of the aforementioned provision shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 11. In the 2018 contract with the Fiesta Commission, the alcohol policy for public Fiesta events specifies that all beverages would be served in a plastic or paper container or aluminum can/bottle. City Council hereby grants an exception to Municipal Code Section 32-30 in order to allow the use of aluminum can/bottle in the Market Square Complex.
