

RFCA #23-190424

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Deputy Chief Financial Officer or designee, authorizes award recommendations from a competitive solicitation process for programming related to Web Presence, Growth Fund, Ecosystem Enhancements and Back Office Support, in the amount of \$5,050,000.00 for thirty-two months. Funding is available through State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLRF) made available from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). These funds must be obligated by December 2024 and spent by December 2026. There is no impact to the general fund.

SECTION 2. Awards are proposed for 5 Agencies for total funding in the amount of \$5,050,000.00. Contract executions are expected to begin March 2023 and will end December 2025. The table below reflects the funds recommended for each of the categories:

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
