## AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING AN EXTENSION AND AMENDMENT OF A CONTRACT WITH ROCKY MOUNTAIN INSTITUTE FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES TO SUPPORT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S CLIMATE ACTION AND ADAPTATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City, through the Office of Sustainability, effective October 1, 2022, entered into a professional services agreement with Rocky Mountain Institute for providing technical assistance services to support implementation of the City's Climate Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the professional services agreement between the Office of Sustainability of the City and Rocky Mountain Institute was for a value of Forty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred dollars and no/100 (\$49,500.00) to provide the stated services; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the project on which City's Office of Sustainability and Rocky Mountain Institute has expanded to address additional items related to the plan, including on-site solar which require the additional expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this expansion of the scope of the project is anticipated to cost an additional Sixty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and no/100 (\$65,500.00) for a total expenditure not to exceed One Hundred and Fifteen Thousand Dollars and no/100 (\$115,000.00); and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes Rocky Mountain Institute to continue to work with the City's Office of Sustainability in the implementation of the City's Climate Action and Implementation Plan; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The extension and amendment of the professional services agreement between the City and the Rocky Mountain Institute in the amount of Sixty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and no/110 (\$65,500.00) is hereby approved and brings the total expenditure not to exceed One Hundred and Fifteen Thousand Dollars and no/100 (\$115,000.00).

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager, or his designee, or the Director, Office of Sustainability, or his designee may execute the extension and amendment with Rocky Mountain Institute for a term of one additional year. The term of the Agreement shall begin after approval by the City. A copy of the Agreement, in substantially final form, is attached and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I.** The execution authority granted by this ordinance shall expire 60 days from the effective date.

**SECTION 3.** Funding in the amount of \$65,500.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 29652000, Cost Center 8055030001 and General Ledger 5201040 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

**SECTION 4.** Payment is authorized to Rocky Mountain Institute RMI) and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

**SECTION 5.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.
