Background



- The 2016 SA Tomorrow Multimodal Transportation plan recommended the development of a Transportation Demand Management (TDM) plan
- A September 2017 Council Consideration Request (CCR) to create a City **TDM** Program
- In 2018 the City received an Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO)/Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) grant for \$750,000 to fund a City-employee focused TDM Plan
- October 2019 City Vanpool program created in partnership with VIA Metropolitan Transit*
