Background



- The 2011 San Antonio Bicycle Master Plan & Implementation Strategy, led by the City of San Antonio's Office of Environmental Policy, was adopted by San Antonio City Council on September 29, 2011
 - \$150,000 was subsequently allocated for plan implementation
- Funding for Bike IMP (\$1,000,000 annually) began in 2016
- The 2011 Bicycle Master Plan eventually required an update to enhance safety & accessibility and to be competitive for future federal funding
- \$2.7 million was allocated in the FY 2022
 Budget to update the 2011 Bike Master Plan
 into the Bike Network Plan (BNP)
