**ORDINANCE**

**CANVASSING THE MAY 6, 2023 GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS**

**WHEREAS**, the general election was held on Saturday, May 6, 2023, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio; and

**WHEREAS**, the voters of the City of San Antonio were asked to elect members of the City Council for Places 1 through 10, each member to be elected by a majority vote of the qualified electors voting in the election in the particular district, and to elect a Mayor (Place 11), elected by a majority of all qualified electors voting in the election; and

**WHEREAS**, the names of the candidates were submitted to the voters, the election was held and conducted, and the returns were made, as required by the City Charter and the laws of the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to the election, including the ordering, notices, election officers, holding and returns, and it is now necessary to declare the official results of the canvass; **NOW THEREFORE**:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council having convened on this 17<sup>h</sup> day of May, 2023, to canvass the returns of the general election held on May 6, 2023, and after canvassing the returns of this election, officially finds and determines that this election was duly ordered; proper notice of this election was given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to this election; the election was duly held; the City has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act, the Texas Election Code, and the City Charter; and due returns of the result of this election have been made and delivered, all in accordance with the law and the Ordinance calling the election.
