ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH KILGORE INDUSTRIES, L.P., TO PROVIDE AND REPLACE THE EXISTING LIFT STATION PUMPS AT THE LOADING DOCKS AT THE ALAMODOME FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$133,563.00 FOR THE CONVENTION AND SPORTS FACILITIES DEPARTMENT. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE IN THE ALAMODOME IMPROVEMENT AND CONTINGENCY FUND FY 2023 ADOPTED BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide and replace the existing lift station pumps at the loading docks at the Alamodome for the City's Convention and Sports Facilities Department; and

WHEREAS, the current lift station pumps are over 15 years old at the Alamodome and are now displaying wear and tear due to usage, thus having surpassed their useful life and are currently out of commission; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the existing lift station pumps to be replaced to prevent potential flooding and to protect existing equipment; and

WHEREAS, Kilgore Industries, L.P., submitted the low bid for a total cost of \$133,563.00; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Kilgore Industries, L.P., to provide and replace the existing lift station pumps at the loading docks at the Alamodome for the City's Convention and Sports Facilities Department for a total cost of \$133,563.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$133,563.00 is available in Fund 29018000, Cost Center 4529010001 and General Ledger 5204050 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Payment is authorized to pay Kilgore Industries, L.P., and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost
