## **ORDINANCE**

APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$2,245,509.00, INCLUDED IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2023 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) BIG TEX CONTRACTORS, LLC, FOR DEMOLITION AND DECONSTRUCTION SERVICES; AND (B) RATIFYING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE ALAMODOME PARKING LOT POINT OF SALE SYSTEM CONTRACT WITH PARKHUB, INC.

WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance (A) approves a contract with Big Tex Contractors, LLC, for demolition and deconstruction services; and (B) ratifies a change order to the Alamodome parking lot point of sale contract with ParkHub, Inc., which allowed the Alamodome to transition immediately to credit card only transactions when events resumed at the Alamodome; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; NOW THEREFORE:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The bid submitted by Big Tex Contractors, LLC, for demolition and deconstruction services as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheet is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements, and the change order to the Alamodome parking lot point of sale contract with ParkHub, Inc., is hereby ratified. The bid tabulation sheet and change order are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

**SECTION 2.** Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2023 budget, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
