ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH JOHNSON HEALTH TECH RETAIL, INC., TO PROVIDE AND INSTALL FITNESS EQUIPMENT FOR VARIOUS FIRE FACILITIES OF THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR A COST OF \$264,399.17, AND A TRADE IN ALLOWANCE OF \$5,000.00, FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$259,339.17. FUNDING IS FROM THE FY 2023 GENERAL FUND BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Johnson Health Tech Retail, Inc., through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the "Buyboard"), to provide and install fitness equipment for various fire facilities of the San Antonio Fire Department for a cost of \$264,399.17, and a trade in allowance of \$5,000, for a total cost of \$259,339.17; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer submitted by Johnson Health Tech Retail, Inc., to provide and install fitness equipment for various fire facilities of the San Antonio Fire Department for a cost of \$264,399.17, and a trade in allowance of \$5,000, for a total cost of \$259,339.17, is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation and contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$259,339.17 is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 2015090001, and General Ledger 5501055 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Payment is authorized to Johnson Health Tech Retail, Inc., and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
