

Project & Solicitation Overview


Aviation Department has coordinated with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) on multi-phase & multi-year airfield projects through project completion.

- Runway 13R/31L Keel Reconstruction
- Reconstruct Taxiway N South of Taxiway D
- Runway 13R/31L Safety Enhancements

Contract will provide engineering and design services; solicitation and construction phases support; and, construction management and inspection services.







Airfield Engineering Design Services

Recommend one airfield engineering design consultant who will serve as the prime consultant with a number of subcontracting opportunities:

- **Coordination:** Prime consultant will serve as engineer of record for projects and be responsive to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the City;
- **Cost Savings:** Utilize economy of scale for similar services in overlapping areas including inspections, surveying and construction materials testing services;
- Disadvantaged Business Enterprise: 19% Good Faith Effort Goal
 - FAA prohibits geographic location as a consideration; but similar federallyfunded projects at SAT have included local DBEs
 - SAT has hosted a public outreach event (in-person and virtual) for firms to learn about upcoming contracts, with over 140 attendees
