Grant Summary

- Purpose
 - Reduce alcohol-related traffic crashes and subsequent fatalities and injuries
 - Public Education and information campaigns
- Period: October 2021 to September 2022
- Grant Award - \$50,000
 - In-kind match of \$12,500
- Funds overtime to resources dedicated to augment SAPD's efforts to reduce the incidence of DWI

DWI Grant Enforcement – 2021



Activity	2021 YTD
DWI Arrests	61
Felony Arrests	72
Citations Issued	336
Warnings Issued	579
Vehicle Stops	772
Personnel Hours	751

Grant Award

- \$50,000 from TxDot for DWI traffic enforcement on an overtime basis to help augment the SAPD's efforts to reduce the incidence of DWI
- \$12,500 In-Kind from the cost of the vehicles (fuel, maintenance, repairs, etc.) used while performing grant activities and the administrative salary of personnel to manage the grant.
