ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A SPORTS LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH GOLD MEDAL ATHLETICS FOR OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE, AND PROGRAMMING OF A DESIGNATED SPORTS FIELD AT STINSON PARK IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 3.

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WHEREAS, Gold Medal Athletics has been a licensee of a sports field located at Stinson Park since 2017; and

WHEREAS, the League provides organized youth sports and serves over 100 area youth each year; and

WHEREAS, the licensed area is shared with the Pop Warner Southside Little Cowboys; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2017, the City and Gold Medal Athletics entered into a 5-year Sports License Agreement for the operations, maintenance, and programming of a sports field at Stinson Park in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement will expire on December 31, 2021, and a new Sports License Agreement is proposed to commence on January 1, 2022 and expire on December 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of rent, the league shall be responsible for operations and maintenance of the designated sports field; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the league will be permitted to operate concessions with proceeds benefiting their program and used to offset the cost of operations and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy ordinance requirements were waived due to the lack of small, minority, and/or women businesses available to provide these goods and services; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department or designee, is hereby authorized to execute a Sports License Agreement with Gold Medal Athletics for operations, maintenance and programming of a designated sports field at Stinson Park for a five (5) year term. A copy of the License Agreement in substantially final form is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. No Fiscal Impact.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
