AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN ADDITIONAL \$4,400,000.00 IN U.S. TREASURY EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FUNDS AND APPROVING AN AMENDED AGREEMENT WITH BEXAR COUNTY FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO BEXAR COUNTY RESIDENTS RESIDING OUTSIDE OF THE SAN ANTONIO CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2020, City Council approved, through Ordinance 2020-04-23-0277, the creation of the Emergency Housing Assistance Program ("EHAP"), which is administered by the Neighborhood and Housing Services Department ("NHSD"); and

WHEREAS, the EHAP provides eligible applicants rental, mortgage, and utility assistance; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2021, City Council approved, through Ordinance 2021-06-17-0446, a \$5,500,000.00 agreement with Bexar County to provide rental assistance to County residents with U.S. Treasury Emergency Rental Assistance ("ERA") grant funds; and

WHEREAS, Bexar County wishes to provide to the City an additional \$4,400,000.00 in ERA grant funds to support the EHAP by providing funds to Bexar County residents who reside outside the San Antonio city limits and are in need of rental assistance; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends amending the existing agreement with Bexar County to add the additional \$4,400,000.00 in ERA funds to the existing EHAP for the purpose of the City's administration of the EHAP to Bexar County residents; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to approve staff's recommendation to amend the existing agreement with Bexar County and to accept the additional ERA funds. NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the acceptance of an additional Four Million, Four Hundred Thousand and 00/100 (\$4,400,000.00) in U.S. Treasury Emergency Rental Assistance ("ERA") grant funds for rental assistance from Bexar County ("County") for the City's administration of the COVID-19 Emergency Housing Assistance Program ("EHAP").

SECTION 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute the amended agreement with Bexar County for the administration of emergency rental assistance to residents outside the city limits but who reside within Bexar County as a part of the City's COVID-19 Emergency Housing Assistance Program, a copy of said agreement is attached as **Attachment I.**

SECTION 3. The City Manager or his designee, the Director of the Neighborhood and Housing Services Department ("NHSD") or her designee, and the Assistant Director of NHSD are each hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all other necessary documents associated with the City's administration of the EHAP including contracts, subawards, and contract amendments to implement and administer the program.

SECTION 4. Upon acceptance of this Ordinance, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the award amount up to \$4,400,000.00 will be appropriated from the U.S. Treasury. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon receipt.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL GRANT AGREEMENT FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FOR RENTAL ASSISTANCE (hereinafter referred to as the "First Amendment") is made and entered by and between the COUNTY OF BEXAR, a political subdivision of the State of Texas ("County"), and the CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, a Texas Home Rule Municipality ("City") Data Universal Number System (DUNS) number 066428400000 (also, individually, a "Party" or, collectively, the "Parties), pursuant to the authority granted by the provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Agreement to have the City to distribute rental assistance funds to eligible County residents ("Services") was approved by San Antonio City Council and by the Bexar County Commissioners Court on June 16, 2021, attached as Exhibit "E";

WHEREAS, the County now wishes to add an additional \$4,400,000 of funding to the Agreement, for a total funding amount of \$9,900,000.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE 2 AGREEMENT MODIFICATION

2.01 <u>Section 2.04 of the Agreement</u>. Section 2.04 of the Agreement is deleted and the following is inserted in its place:

"20.04 Following is additional information for pass-through entities pursuant to 2 CFR 200.332:

- a) Federal Award Identification Number: ERA-2101112335
- b) Federal Award Date: January 12, 2021
- c) Name of Federal Awarding Agency: Department of the Treasury
- d) Total Amount of Federal Funds Obligated to CITY by COUNTY including the current financial obligation: \$ 9,900,000.00.
 - e) CFDA Number: 21.023"
- 2.02 <u>Sections 4.01 and 4.02 of the Agreement</u>. Sections 4.01 and 4.02 of the Agreement are deleted and the following are inserted in its place:
 - "4.01 For actual and eligible Rental Assistance and Administrative Costs (as defined below), COUNTY will reimburse CITY an amount not to exceed **NINE MILLION**, **NINE**

HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$9,900,000).

- 4.02 COUNTY will reimburse administrative costs allowed under Treasury guidelines ("Administrative Costs"). Pursuant to Treasury guidelines, Administrative Costs can include costs attributable to providing financial assistance and housing stability services, including data collection and reporting requirements related to such funds. Treasury Funds provided by the COUNTY shall reimburse CITY only for those costs and expenses directly related to the CITY's provision of the services described in **Exhibit "A"**. Administrative Costs may not exceed ten percent of the amount of Rental Assistance distributed, an amount not to exceed **NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$900,000).**"
- 2.03 <u>Section 5.01 of the Agreement</u>. Section 5.01 of the Agreement is deleted and the following is inserted in its place:

"5.01 CITY shall submit to the COUNTY's Economic and Community Development Department ("Department") a monthly invoice package of incurred costs. For purposes of this Agreement, a cost is "incurred" when CITY has expended funds to cover the cost. The invoice package must be submitted, month after month, by the 5th of the following month, until funding has been exhausted. The invoice package should include in the form incorporated into this Agreement as **Exhibit "F"**: (1) an Expenditure Report itemizing Rental Assistance and Administrative Costs; (2) Participating Household Payment Data; (3) Demographic Information; (4) Zip Code Report; (5) Quarterly Report; and (6) ECD Invoice Cover Sheet.
