Post-solicitation high profile item for Citywide Outside Plant, Vertical & Horizontal Cabling

### **SUMMARY:**

Post-Solicitation briefing for Citywide Outside Plant, Vertical & Horizontal Cabling

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Information Technology Services Department solicited proposals for cable/fiber pulling and installation services primarily for the installation of CAT 5E/CAT 6/CAT 6A communications cabling, 25 pair copper cabling, multimode and single mode indoor/outdoor fiber facilities, telecommunications grounding/bonding, installation of underground telecommunications infrastructure and telecommunication design/project management services. Contractor will be responsible for all required labor, materials, necessary tools, test equipment, testing and transport to and from job sites.

### **ISSUE:**

Solicitation Type: Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP)

Contract Value: \$3.1 Million annually (Micro Category)

Term of Contract: 3 years with 2, 1-year renewal options

Number of Respondents: 7 (Three respondents were deemed non-responsive for failure to meet the 15% M/WBE subcontracting requirement and one respondent was deemed non-responsive for failure to submit the required best and final offer)

Contracts to be Awarded: 1 contract (Micro Category)
