A request for a change in zoning from "C-2 H HS AHOD" Commercial Historic Lavaca Historic Significant Airport Hazard Overlay District to "C-2 CD H HS AHOD" Commercial Historic Lavaca Historic Significant Airport Hazard Overlay District with a Conditional Use for a Tattoo Parlor on the south 80.3 feet of Lot 1, Block 13, NCB 716, located at 724 South Alamo Street.
