ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A TASK ORDER FOR A CONTRACT WITH HAGERTY CONSULTING, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$57,000.00 FOR HAZARD MITIGATION PLANNING SUPPORT.

WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 2019-02-14-0124 City Council authorized Hagerty Consulting, inc. (Hagerty) to provide services to the City on a Task Order basis for compensation as provided in the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Fire Department would like to have professional assistance in regard to their Hazard Mitigation planning; and

WHEREAS, Hagerty has agreed to provide Hazard Mitigation Planning Support to the Fire Department pursuant to a Task Order for a total price of \$57,000.00; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and designee is authorized to issue a Task Order for a contract with Hagerty in an amount not to exceed \$57,000.00 for Hazard Mitigation Planning Support.

SECTION 2: Funding in the amount of \$57,000.00 for this ordinance is available in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 8002060071 and General Ledger 5201040 as part of the Fiscal Year 2022 Adopted Budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3: Payment is authorized to Hagerty Consulting and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4: The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage upon receipt of eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, this ordinance is effective ten days after passage.
