Project Background

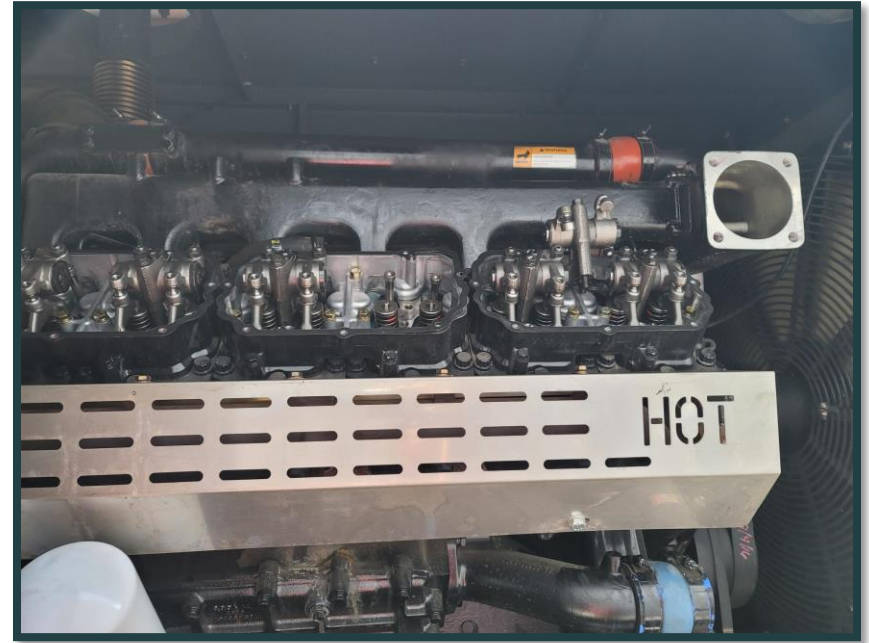
- Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) is located on Brooks City Base
- Constructed in 2012
- Building houses the 911 emergency dispatch services for SAPD and SAFD
- PSAP relies on 4 emergency back up generators
 - 2 of the 4 are designed to provide power redundancy for the facility
- One generator was replaced in January 2020.





Project Scope and Benefits

- Purchase and replacement of generator
- Equal configuration and capacity to the original equipment currently on site
- Will provide emergency power redundancy to the facility
- 5 year comprehensive parts and labor warranty from manufacturer
- 2 year comprehensive labor warranty from installer
