This Proposal is offered as set forth in the terms and conditions of the contract and the statement of work as amended by a more detailed statement of work attached.

Proposal Breakdown:

Quartz: \$139,338.30

Waterline Tile and Transition Tile: \$15,610.38

Marker Tiles in and Out of Pool: \$7,103.99

Coping: \$21,848.00

Rebar: \$56,278.28

Gunite: \$212,311.80

(To meet State and Federal VGB codes) Equipment & Plumbing: \$231,935.40

<u>Scope of Work: <mark>\$698,114.68</mark></u>

- Remove concrete deck at the deep end of pool to run all new plumbing to equipment.
- Drill and pin and epoxy 1/2" rebar into the deck and floor of existing pool every 4" and make a 4"X4" grid.
- Install 26- 2" Bermuda skimmers to existing pool and plumb with 6" PVC. (To meet State and Federal VGB codes)
- Remove existing main drains in deep end and form a 2'X2'X3' sump with 10" plumbing and run to the equipment pad. (To meet State and Federal VGB codes)
- Install 24 new return lines in pool and run PVC to equipment pad.
- Reform steps in pool to make them bigger.
- Shoot approximately 600 yards of concrete Gunite 12" thick to walls and floor of existing pool.
- Install new 12"X24"X2" Ivory Travertine coping to new pool shell.
- Install new 6"X6" waterline tile to new pool shell.
- Set new depth marker tiles in pool and on deck every 25 foot. (To meet City, State and Federal codes)
- Install return line fittings in pool. (Eyeballs & SP1022)
- Apply interior finish to pool. (Quartz) (white with blue rock) (with a Limited 7 year manufacturer's warranty)
- Install new non-slip step tile on all steps and benches in pool. (To meet State and Federal codes)
- Tool step and bench edges with finish material.
- Install 2 new 24"X24" anti-vortex main drain frames and grates to pool. (To meet VGB Federal code)
- Install 4 new stainless 4-tread ladders in pool.
- Fill pool water supplied by owner.
- Pool startup and balance by MPG.
- Install 1 new 15HP pump and 1 new filter to match existing equipment.
- Remove plumbing from existing pumps and filters and dispose.
- Replumb existing and new equipment with the proper size plumbing and fittings. (To meet State and Federal VGB codes)

Assumptions & Clarifications:

- 1. Daily Clean up of site is included.
- 2. No work not specified in the above scope of work.
- 3. We exclude all unforeseen conditions.
