## **ORDINANCE**

APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL \$226,000.00, **INCLUDED COST OF** IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2022 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) SUPERIOR COLLISION CENTER, LLC, FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE SERVICES; (B) VEHICLE COLLISION **BODY** REPAIR WORLDWIDE, INC., FOR ARTS AND CRAFTS SUPPLIES; AND (C) HILL'S PET NUTRITION SALES, INC., FOR DOG AND CAT FOOD.

WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The following bids to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements: (A) Superior Collision Center for Emergency Medical Service (EMS) vehicle collision body repair services; (B) S&S Worldwide, Inc., for arts and crafts supplies; and (C) Hill's Pet Nutrition Sales, Inc., for dog and cat food. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2022 budget, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
