

# Background

- 17 members + 17 alternates
  - NOT city employees
  - Qualified on building-related and fire codes
  - At-large positions
- Working members and trade organizations for:
  - Reappointments
  - Filling vacancies
  - Member replacement for those wanting to step down
- Nominations in writing by industry associations affiliated with nationally recognized organizations
  - Asked to reflect diversity found in City of San Antonio
  - Appointed by City Council
- Ch10-14(d) qualifications for board members and recommendations from industry organizations



## Overview

- Board can:
  - administratively switch primary & alternate designations within same category
  - fill vacant primary positions with alternate members within same category
- Hears & decides appeals of orders, decisions or determinations made by the *Building Official* or *Fire Marshal* about application and interpretations of:
  - Ch. 10
  - Ch. 11
  - Ch.28 specific articles
- Assist in the 2021 Development Code adoption process
- Dec. 13, 2021 Presented to the Planning and Community Development Committee



### ICC Building, Sign & Property Maintenance Codes Process Update

- Adopt 10 2021 I-Codes and 2020 NEC:
- Internal review by DSD staff
- Open meetings with Building-Related and Fire Codes Appeals and Advisory Board, Building Standards Board (BSB), Committees and Stakeholders
- Approval from full BRFCAAB and BSB (Property Maintenance Code)
- Consideration by City Council anticipated in late summer 2022
- 90-day period after City Council approval before enforcement
