The applicant is requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness for approval to install wayfinding signage for the ZONA Cultural project.

## **APPLICABLE CITATIONS:**

Sec. 35-645. - Signs and Billboards on Public Property or Right-of-Way.

(a) General Provisions. All non-regulatory signage on public property, on the public right-of-way, or overhanging the public right-of-way shall conform to all city codes and must be approved by the historic preservation officer prior to installation. Permits must be obtained following approval of the application. The historic preservation officer may submit an application under this section to the historic and design review commission for their recommendation prior to approving, denying, or approving with conditions the application. Memorials, markers, naming rights of public property, and recognition of charitable donations given to the City of San Antonio shall be additionally governed by existing policies for memorials and markers and/or any formal action passed by city council. Temporary displays approved by the department exercising control of the public property are authorized if in accordance with chapter 28 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas.

## **FINDINGS:**

- a. The applicant has proposed to install approximately twenty-one (21) wayfinding signs with directional information and seven (7) wayfinding signs with interpretive information within the Zona Cultural project area between Cattleman Square to the east, Main Plaza to the west, W Cesar Chavez to the south, and E Houston to the north. The applicant has proposed to install the interpretive wayfinding signs markers on the 800 block of W Commerce, the 100 block of San Saba, the 100 block of Santa Rosa, the 300 block of W Commerce, the 100-200 block of Santa Rosa, and the 300-400 block of Santa Rosa.
- b. CASE HISTORY The Zona Cultural project previously received HDRC approval for right-of-way improvements along the West Commerce Corridor between S Santa Rosa and S St Mary's and between Frio Street and Alazan Creek, HDRC Case Numbers 2018-374 and 2020-213, respectively. The approved scopes of work included new curbing and paving, pedestrian lighting, landscaping, the installation of benches, and the installation of decorative sidewalk elements. Previous applications have included information on proposed information kiosks and VIA bus shelters that were not reviewed or approved by the HDRC. The applicant has returned to the HDRC for the review of additional wayfinding signage.
- c. DIRECTIONAL WAYFINDING SIGNAGE DESIGN The applicant is requesting approval to install approximately twenty-one (21) directional wayfinding signs within the Zona Cultural project area. The applicant has not provided final height or material information at this time. The applicant has proposed wayfinding signage approximately 7 ½ feet in height with a metallic finish, featuring the Zona Cultural Greca pattern. Staff finds that the applicant should provide final dimensions and material specifications for the proposed directional signage to staff for review and approval. The proposed signage design is generally appropriate.
- d. DIRECTIONAL WAYFINDING SIGNAGE LOCATION The applicant is requesting approval to install approximately twenty-one (21) directional wayfinding signs within the Zona Cultural project area. Staff finds


- that the applicant should submit finalized directional signage locations to staff for review and approval prior to receiving a Certificate of Appropriateness.
- e. INTERPRETIVE WAYFINDING SIGNAGE DESIGN The applicant is requesting approval to install approximately seven (7) interpretive wayfinding signs within the Zona Cultural project area. The applicant has not provided final height or material information at this time. The applicant has proposed wayfinding signage approximately 8 feet in height with a metallic finish, featuring the Zona Cultural Greca pattern. The interpretive signs proposed will feature interpretive text and contextual photos with uniform text, font size, and overall layout. The applicant has proposed interpretive signs focused on the railroad & westside, the Chili Queens and Market Square, immigration and Market Square, Spanish theatres, Main Plaza and Commerce Street, Publisher's Row, and Barrio Laredito. The applicant has committed to reviewing and finalizing the interpretive text with the City's Cultural Historian. Staff finds that the applicant should provide final dimensions and material specifications for the proposed interpretive signage to staff for review and approval. Staff finds that the proposed plaque is in accordance with UDC Section 35-645 and is appropriate.
- f. INTERPRETIVE WAYFINDING SIGNAGE LOCATION –The applicant has proposed to install the interpretive wayfinding signs on the 800 block of W Commerce (railroad and westside), the 100 block of San Saba (Chili Queens/Market Square), the 100 block of Santa Rosa (Immigration/Market Square), the 300 block of W Commerce (Spanish theatres), the 100 block of E Commerce (Main Plaza/Commerce Street), the 100-200 block of Santa Rosa (Publisher's Row), and the 300-400 block of Santa Rosa (Barrio Laredito). The interpretive text will correspond to the location of the wayfinding signage. Staff finds that the applicant should submit finalized interpretive signage locations to staff for review and approval prior to receiving a Certificate of Appropriateness.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval based on findings a through f with the following stipulations:


- i. That the applicant submits final dimensions and material specifications for the proposed interpretive signage to staff for review and approval prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Appropriateness.
- ii. That the applicant submits an updated site plan with finalized signage locations to staff for review and approval prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Appropriateness.
