<b>SA2020 Commission on Education</b>	
Name	Change name from <u>SA2020 Commission on Education</u> → <u>City of San Antonio Commission on Education</u> <i>[Article I, Name]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Rationale:</i> Distinguish between separate non-profit and City commission; Further City’s vision beyond 2020</li> </ul>
Purpose; Responsibilities	Strike references to SA2020 goals, indicators, measures and vision; reference general goals of Commission to impact educational outcomes of SA residents <i>[Article II, Purpose; Article III, Responsibilities]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Rationale:</i> Further City’s vision beyond 2020</li> </ul>
Term Limit	Eliminate 2 two year term limit <i>[Article IV, Membership; Section 2, Term of Membership]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Rationale:</i> Change is consistent with current City Code, which allows for unlimited terms; allows for continued service of active, contributing appointees</li> </ul>
Attendance	Allow appointing Councilmember, or Mayor in the case of at-large appointments, to review and determine whether to remove a board member (change from 3 absences resulting in a recommendation to remove) <i>[Article IV – Termination of Membership]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Rationale:</i> Councilmember (or Mayor if at large appointment) should decide since his or her representation is affected; Change is consistent with current City Code regarding absences</li> </ul>
Subcommittees	Remove Standing Bylaws Evaluation Committee <i>[Article VII – Subcommittees]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Rationale:</i> Unnecessary requirement to have a standing committee meet regularly when evaluation may be performed by forming a Special Committee if, and when, necessary</li> </ul>
Council Committee Reporting	Strike reference to Educational Excellence Council Committee and replace with reference to “appropriate” Council Committee <i>[Article IX – Reporting]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Rationale:</i> Eliminates need to periodically update a named Council Committee</li> </ul>

Purpose; Responsibilities	Strike references to SA2020 goals, indicators, measures and vision; <i>[Article II, Purpose; Article III, Responsibilities]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Rationale:</i> Further City’s vision beyond 2020</li> </ul>
Attendance	Allow appointing Councilmember, or Mayor in the case of at-large appointments, to review and determine whether to remove a board member (change from 3 absences resulting in a recommendation to remove) <i>[Article IV – Termination of Membership]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>Rationale:</i> Councilmember (or Mayor if at large appointment) should decide since his or her representation is affected; Change is consistent with current City Code regarding absences</li> </ul>

Appointment Process	Eliminate need for University nomination <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rationale: Simplifies appointment process which previously delayed appointment</li> </ul>
Bylaws	N/A (no modification) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New Bylaws proposed for Council Approval; substance consistent with Bylaws for other boards presented here</li> </ul>
<b>San Antonio Youth Commission</b>	
Bylaws	N/A (no modification) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New Bylaws proposed for Council Approval; substance consistent with Bylaws for other boards presented here</li> </ul> Bylaws
Quorum	Consists of a majority of appointed members vs. a majority of seats on the Board <i>[Article VI, Meetings, Section 1, Paragraph 2]</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rationale: Proposed variation from the Boards and Commissions rules since it is difficult to reach quorum for a student board with 22 seats; quorum based upon <i>appointed</i> members allows for fewer cancelled meetings due to lack of quorum</li> </ul>
