## RFCA #21-4059

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, is authorized to execute an agreement with Meadows Mental Health Policy Institute for the implementation of the Mobile Mental Wellness Collaborative for an initial term ending September 30, 2022, with a one-year renewal option for a total amount up to \$1,147,336.00 inclusive of the renewal. Funding for the agreement is available and budgeted in the Health Disparities grant fund in the amount of \$500,000.00. Funding in the amount of \$315,190.00 is available from the FY 2022 Strategic Growth Plan Budget. The funding for the second-year costs in the amount of \$332,146.00 is subject to City Council Approval in FY 2023.

**SECTION 2.** Funding is available from Internal Order Number 136000001815 and Fund 2103600010 entitled "Health Disparities COVID", for a total amount up to \$500,000.00. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to the Meadows Mental Health Policy Institute upon issuance of a purchase order.

**SECTION 3.** Funding is available from Internal Order Number 836000000161 and Fund 29836000 entitled "Health Donations", for a total amount up to \$315,190.00. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to the Meadows Mental Health Policy Institute upon issuance of a purchase order.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
