ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL \$3,740,000.00, **INCLUDED** IN COST OF THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENT'S FY 2022 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) TRASTAR, INC., MOBOTREX, INC., TRAFFIC & PARKING CONTROL CO., INC., K&K INC., SYSTEMS. TWINCREST INC., DBA TWINCREST TECHNOLOGIES, AND ITERIS, INC., FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL COMPONENTS; (B) SIDDONS MARTIN EMERGENCY GROUP, LLC, AND FRAZER, LTD., FOR PARTS AND SERVICE FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES; (C) PREMIER COURTS LIMITED COMPANY FOR PLEXIPAVE SPORT COURT RESURFACING; AND (D) ALAMO INDUSTRIAL GROUP, INC., DBA ACE WELDING & TRAILER COMPANY, FOR FIRE AND PUMPER VEHICLE BODY REPAIR SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves contracts with (A) TraStar, Inc., MoboTrex, Inc., Traffic & Parking Control Co., Inc., K&K Systems Inc., Twincrest Inc., dba Twincrest Technologies, and Iteris, Inc., for traffic signal components; (B) Siddons Martin Emergency Group, LLC, and Frazer, Ltd., for parts and service for emergency vehicles; (C) Premier Courts Limited Company for Plexipave sport court resurfacing; and (D) Alamo Industrial Group, Inc., dba Ace Welding & Trailer Company, for fire and pumper vehicle body repair services; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by General Traffic Equipment Corp. for item 2A and Traffic Logix, Corp., for item 9 failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for traffic signal components; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following bids to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements: with (A) TraStar, Inc., MoboTrex, Inc., Traffic & Parking Control Co., Inc., K&K Systems Inc., Twincrest Inc., dba Twincrest Technologies, and Iteris, Inc., for traffic signal components; (B) Siddons Martin Emergency Group, LLC, and Frazer, Ltd., for parts and service for emergency vehicles; (C) Premier Courts Limited Company for Plexipave sport court resurfacing; and (D)

Alamo Industrial Group, Inc., dba Ace Welding & Trailer Company, for fire and pumper vehicle body repair services. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the bid submitted by General Traffic Equipment Corp. for item 2A and Traffic Logix, Corp., for item 9 failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements for traffic signal components.

SECTION 3. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2022 budget, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
