Issue Proposed for Consideration

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest available meeting of the Governance Committee:

The re-naming of the Plaza de Armas area in front of City Hall to Inclusion Plaza.

Brief Background

Historically, Main and Military Plaza have been the seat of government in San Antonio since their formation by Spanish Settlers in 1722.

Over the three centuries of San Antonio’s rich history, this area has been a site for public rallies and parades, the submission of community petitions, and – more recently – press conferences for local government and organizations.

With the new renovations of City Hall that now include a fully accessible front entrance, it would be impactful for us to appropriately name the plaza after the spirit in which these improvements were undertaken – inclusion.

That is why I request that we rename the Plaza de Armas area in front of City Hall to Inclusion Plaza.


