


Tree Variance Appeal

PURPOSE OF THE ORDINANCE

- The code intends to balance:
 - The protection of existing trees
 - Promote planting of new trees
 - Allow for development to occur
- Allows for certain % of tree removal
 - 40% preservation Significant Trees (6" 23")
 - Up to 80% may be mitigated
 - 100% Preservation Heritage Trees (24" or more)
 - Up to 80% may be mitigated
- Minimum overall canopy requirement for projects




VARIANCES

- Are NOT waivers
- They are referenced and specifically allowed within the tree ordinance
 - Since 1997 ordinance
- Are alternative ways to meet intent of the code when hardships exist

PROJECT DETAILS


- TPV 21-147
- SAT 14 Data Center Shell
 - Project number 21-39801977
 - 3545 Wiseman Blvd. Council District 6
- Article V, Sec. 35-523 (f), Table 523-1A
 - 40% Preservation Significant Trees
 - Up to 80% of Significant Trees may be mitigated rather than preserved
 - 100% Preservation Heritage Trees
 - Up to 80% of Heritage Trees may be mitigated rather than preserved





APPEAL OVERVIEW

- Owned by Microsoft Corporation
- Applicant David Lundberg Walter P. Moore
- Proposed applicant hardship:
 - Site not developable for proposed use without substantial re-grading and removal of trees of nearly the entire area to:
 - accommodate building pads and circulation
 - trenches required for numerous underground utilities

TOTAL MITIGATION (PROPOSED)


- Total required = 8,964"
 - 1,530" (heritage) + 7,525" (significant) 91" (preserved non-protected trees)
- Mitigation method: Planting/Payment
 - 833 trees planted
 - 1,836" planted
 - **7,386**" remaining mitigation
 - \$1,477,240.00 paid into fund for remaining mitigation
 - \$200 per inch



RECOMMENDATION

- Staff recommends **denial** of proposed Tree Variance
 - This would overturn variance approval by Planning Commission
 - Removal of significant and heritage trees significantly below minimum preservation requirements
 - Does not meet intent and spirit of Tree Ordinance
- Note that approval of Tree Variance would confirm
 December 15th Planning Commission decision





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
