- New: Disease Intervention Specialists (DIS) Workforce Grant for STD/HIV prevention
 - Up to \$571,977 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

Authorizing MOAs associated with these projects at no cost to City



- 21 grant renewals up to \$14,163,068
- Term: July 1, 2022 to December 31, 2023
- The City will provide an estimated \$334,692.00 in in-kind services from the General Fund for these grants
- EHE grant funded agreements:
 - \$35,000 each for term ending July 31, 2022 with option to renew for total amount up to \$70,000 inclusive of renewal
