

The Aviation Department coordinates with the Federal Aviation Administration for continued Airfield Improvement Program (AIP) grant funding for eligible large and critical airfield projects at the San Antonio International Airport. This solicitation will select a qualified firm that will provide airfield engineering and design services, to include solicitation and construction phase services, for the following three projects:

- a. Runway 13R/31L Keel Reconstruction and Outboard Rehabilitation
- b. Runway 13R/31L Safety Enhancements
- c. Reconstruct Taxiway N South of Taxiway D
