### **SUBJECT:**

Briefing on Community Vaccination Clinics.

# **SUMMARY:**

ACS is working with the Animal Defense League (ADL) to provide free community vaccination clinics throughout the community.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

ACS has contracted with ADL to provide 12 free vaccination clinics of 100 pets per clinic throughout San Antonio. ACS has secured locations in the areas with the greatest needs for resources. Clinics will start January 2022. The clinics are only for San Antonio residents. ACS will try to expand the number of clinics with other vendors going forward.

Clinics will provide vaccinations to protects against DHPP (distemper, hepatitis, parvovirus, and

parainfluenza), Bordetella, and FVRCP (feline viral rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, and panleukopenia), as well as rabies vaccines and registered microchips.
