Contract Award: 2022 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings, Package C

SUMMARY:

An ordinance accepting the lowest responsive bid and awarding the 2022 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings, Package C to M&M Striping & Power Washing, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$315,460.00.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Project Background

With the adoption of the FY 2022 Budget on September 16, 2021, City Council approved a \$110 million Street Maintenance Program (SMP) budget, comprised of \$12 million in-house and \$98 million in contractual street maintenance projects. This ordinance authorizes one contract for FY 2022 totaling \$315,460.00 to install, replace, and modify pavement markings along roadways that are being resurfaced by in-house forces as part of the SMP.

Procurement of Services

This project was advertised on February 25, 2022, for construction bids in the San Antonio Hart Beat, the City's website, the Texas Electronic State Business Daily, TVSA, and through the

electronic bidding website CivCast. Bids were opened on March 25, 2022 and four (4) bids were received. Of these, M&M Striping & Power Washing, LLC submitted the lowest responsive bid. A bid summary is attached.

This contract will be awarded in compliance with the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program, which requires contracts to be reviewed by a Goal Setting Committee to establish a requirement and/or incentive unique to the particular contract to maximize small, minority, and women-owned business participation on the contract. The Goal Setting Committee set a 27% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting goal. M&M Striping & Power Washing, LLC has committed to meeting the subcontractor participation goal.

This construction contract was developed utilizing the low bid process; therefore, a Contracts Disclosure Form is not required.

ISSUE:

This ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid and awards the 2022 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings, Package C to M&M Striping & Power Washing, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$315,460.00.

As part of the department's continuing efforts to expedite project delivery and complete infrastructure projects, this task order contract will enable Public Works to execute multiple projects delivered through the Street Maintenance Program.

The 2022 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings, Package C includes, but is not limited to, installing, replacing, and modifying pavement markings along roadways and any other required work for the completion of projects located throughout the City.

ALTERNATIVES:

City Council could request staff to re-bid this package; however, re-bidding would delay the delivery of the Street Maintenance Program.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid and awards the 2022 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings, Package C to M&M Striping & Power Washing, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$315,460.00. Funds are available and included in the FY 2022 – FY 2027 Capital Improvements Program and may be funded from various funding sources including, but not limited to, the General Fund, the Advanced Transportation District Fund, debt proceeds, or other funding sources.

The City makes no minimum guarantee pertaining to the volume of work. If funding for any work activities is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the 2022 Task Order Contract for Pavement Markings, Package C to M&M Striping & Power Washing, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$315,460.00 to complete projects identified in the Street Maintenance Program. Additional contracts are scheduled to be awarded at a later date for the remaining Street Maintenance Program projects.
