- F. Appointing Aiden Gonzalez (District 1) to the San Antonio Youth Commission

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Applications for appointments to a board were submitted to the Office of the City Clerk who coordinated review of the applications with the pertinent City Department and the City Attorney's Office. For District seats, the applications of qualified applicants were forwarded to the respective Council Office for review. The City Councilmember submitted a memorandum designating an appointee to each District seat to the Office of the City Clerk for processing.

San Antonio Economic Development Corporation appointments of At-Large Citizen members were interviewed and recommended by the Economic and Workforce Development Committee on August 12, 2022.
