City Council Project Funds Allocations

#### **SUMMARY:**

This Ordinance approves grant allocations through the City Council Project Fund (CCPF) for:

- A) Musical Bridges Around the World Presents: Musical Sprouts and Kids to Concert program. This program provides educational content and resources to over 4,000 children.
- B) "District 3 Back to School Health & Wellness Event", a district-wide community annual Back to School event providing free backpacks with school supplies, school immunizations, and COVID-19 vaccines for families.
- C) "District 4 Back to School Project 2022/2023", an event inviting families of the district with children to take part in the annual tradition of giving out backpacks full of school supplies in preparation for the school year.
- D) "District 2 Heater Giveaway" event, an event where the district distributed heaters to community members in preparation for cold winter months, promoting the health, safety, and welfare of the community

E) "District 9 School Safety Supplies" an event where the district provided school safety supplies to schools within the North East Independent School District

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

(CCPF) was established in 2011 to provide financial support for events and programs that serve a municipal purpose and promote (1) the health, safety and welfare of the community; (2) family, social and economic stability; (3) community fitness/recreation; and (4) community education and training. City Council approval is required for City Council Project Fund allocations exceeding \$10,000 to an applicant for the same program, activity, event, good, or service.

#### This ordinance awards:

A) This respective district allocations in support of Musical Sprouts and Kids to Concert, an original program by Musical Bridges Around the World:

- "Musical Sprouts" is a program that measures the impact of STEAM (STEM + Arts) curricula taught through the medium of music and art in partnership with UT Health Science Center.
- B) \$18,000.00 in CCPF funding for the District 3 annual Back to School event which provided free backpacks with school supplies, school immunizations, and COVID-19 vaccines for families. Health and wellness activities, as well as breakfast and lunch for school children were also available.
- C) \$14,000.00 in CCPF funding for the District 4 Back to School event that provided backpacks full of school supplies to students in the community. District 4 hosted this free event in collaboration with community partners including local school districts, charter schools,

health clinics, and churches.

- D) \$10,489.00 in CCPF funding for the District 2 Heater Giveaway for community members and provided preparation for cold winter months, promoting the health, safety, and welfare of the community.
- E) \$18,153.88 in CCPF funding for the District 9 School Safety Supply distribution for Schools in the North East Independent School District.

### **ISSUE:**

This ordinance seeks to award several CCPF allocations, listed above, to support various District events and activities that meet the criteria for eligibility.

## **ALTERNATIVES:**

City Council could choose not to approve these allocations.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Funding for these allocations was included in the FY 2022 General Fund Budget for CCPF. This ordinance authorizes the following projects:
