SUMMARY:

Post-Solicitation briefing on Operation & Management of the Brackenridge Veterinary Clinic

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Animal Care Services Department (ACS) released a Request for Proposals (RFP) on May 20, 2022, to select a vendor to manage and operate the Brackenridge Veterinary Clinic. Management and operation of the facility includes providing 6,500 low-cost spay/neuter surgeries to the community annually and providing low-cost vaccinations, microchips, and other pet wellness services to the community.
