Culebra Road Multi-Modal Corridor Planning Study

**SUMMARY:**

A briefing on the Culebra Road Multi-Modal Corridor Planning Study.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

In 2018, the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) approved the Multi-Modal Corridor Mobility Planning Studies as Local Agency Managed (LAM) projects of 2019-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Consequently, the City received funding allocation for four (4) multimodal corridor studies, Culebra Road was the first project identified. This corridor was identified because of its continued safety concerns, its status as a Severe Pedestrian Injury Area (SPIA) corridor, and because the roadway's capacity to accommodate various travel modes: vehicle, micro-mobility, pedestrian, and higher transit

capacity is significant.

On May 7, 2020 City Council awarded a professional services agreement to WSP USA, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$979,400.00 to provide design planning concepts for the Multi-Modal Planning Study for Culebra Road from I-10 to Loop 1604. The Scope of Work comprises an engineering focus on traffic data, modeling, Synchro analysis and construction cost estimates.

The Transportation Department paused the study in August of 2021 to ensure sufficient community engagement and input was completed. The department has worked with the consultant to engage the Technical Advisory Group to provide feedback on proposed design concepts for the Culebra study to present in a second round of community engagement. The second round of public engagement open house meetings will take place October 1 and October 4, 2022. The Transportation Department, in collaboration with the consultants will present the proposed design concepts and collect public feedback. The in person community open houses will be held on:

Transportation Department staff and the consultant team will refine the draft study based on community input, with the final Culebra Road Multi-Modal Corridor Planning Study to be completed by November 2022.

The consultant will be on hand to present an update on the project including the draft findings, proposed concepts, and next steps.
