SUBJECT:

Holiday Parking Plan for the San Antonio International Airport

SUMMARY:

Chief Operations Officer Ryan Rocha will brief the Airport Advisory Commission members on the holiday parking plan for the San Antonio International Airport. Airline industry representatives are anticipating a record-breaking 2022 Holiday Travel season.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The San Antonio International Airport has over 8,700 parking spaces throughout the parking system. With the return of air trafficl levels close to record-breaking FY 2019 levels and a change in passenger preference to utilize their own vehicles to travel to the airport, parking levels have exceeded the FY 2022 estimates. Throughout October 2022, the short-term parking garage closed almost daily due to capacity issues.

ISSUE:

Chief Operations Officer will brief the Commission members on parking improvements that have been made to provide additional parking spaces during the peak travel period and the plan for the valet service to provide pre-booking service in the Short-Term Parking Garage. The briefing will provide an opportunity for Commission members to ask questions and provide input of the plan.
