SUBJECT:

City of San Antonio status report on recommendations from the Committee on Emergency Preparedness.

SUMMARY:

The City of San Antonio will present to the Municipal Utilities Committee, an update on the actions taken to address the twenty-four recommendations outlined in the final Committee on Emergency Preparedness report.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

From February 13, 2021 to February 19, 2021, the continental United States experienced a severe winter storm referred to as Winter Storm Uri, which significantly impacted the City of San Antonio. On February 22nd, the Mayor created the Committee on Emergency Preparedness and tasked the Committee with studying the event to determine what happened and to provide

recommendations on what needs to be done to better prepare for future winter weather emergency events. The Committee's Report was presented to City Council on June 24, 2021.
