#### **ANALYSIS:**

**Zoning:** The proposed plat is located outside the city limits of San Antonio; therefore, zoning is not applicable.

Master Development Plan: MDP # 15-00036.01, Westlakes, accepted on June 8, 2018.

#### **ISSUE:**

Military Awareness Zone: The subject property lies within a recognized Military Notification Area (MNA). In accordance with the executed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), the City's Office of Military Affairs and the appropriate Military Installation were notified.

#### **ALTERNATIVES:**

Per State Law, Section 212.009 and Unified Development Code (UDC), Section 35-432(d), the Planning Commission considers staff review of the variance request along with the plat.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approval of a Replat and Subdivision plat that consists of 14.081 acre tract of land, which proposes fifty (53) of single-family residential lots, four (4) non-single family residential lots, and approximately one thousand seven hundred forty three (1,743) linear feet of public streets.
