Interlocal Agreement: Kampmann Boulevard Preliminary Engineering Report (PER)

## **SUMMARY:**

An ordinance approving the execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County to accept and appropriate funds in the amount of \$263,958.00 into the Storm Water Operating Fund from Bexar County for the completion of Kampmann Boulevard Preliminary Engineering Report.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Kampmann Boulevard has an undersized underground drainage system from Babcock Road to Woodlawn Lake. As a result, residents have reported flooding on Kampmann Boulevard and abutting properties.

The Upper Woodlawn Lake Drainage Study conducted by AECOM in September 2012 evaluated potential drainage improvements that could alleviate flooding in the Woodlawn Lake watershed. Several alternatives were considered and evaluated, and the proposed solution identified included the construction of a bypass system. However, as described in the 2012 study, there were questions

about its constructability. A Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) is needed to summarize the analysis of existing drainage issues based on current data to provide feasible solutions.

### **ISSUE:**

This ordinance approves the execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County, accepting funds from Bexar County in an amount not to exceed \$263,958.00 for the completion of Kampmann Boulevard Preliminary Engineering Report (PER), and authorizes the appropriation of these funds from Bexar County to the Kampmann Boulevard (Babcock Road – Woodlawn Lake) project.

The City of San Antonio will manage the execution of the PER. The scope of the PER will include project management, public outreach, data collection, hydrologic modeling, review of existing conditions including previous hydrologic and hydraulic models, proposed conditions and alternatives analysis, and preparation of a PER document. The purpose of PER is to assess potential flooding solutions to provide flooding relief to residents and businesses along Kampmann Boulevard. The PER will model the existing system to current hydraulic and hydrologic standards and identify potential solutions and/or alternatives including downstream impacts, constructability, and cost. Completion of the PER is anticipated in July 2023.

## **ALTERNATIVES:**

As an alternative, City Council could choose not to approve the Interlocal Agreement. However, the City would lose the opportunity to leverage program funding, improve the management of public funding sources, ensure coordination of governmental resources and functions to remove flooding on its public streets and the private property of its residents and businesses.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

This ordinance approving the execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County to accept and appropriate funds in the amount of \$263,958.00 into the Storm Water Operating Fund from Bexar County for the completion of Kampmann Boulevard Preliminary Engineering Report.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance authorizing the execution of an Interlocal Agreement between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County to accept funds from Bexar County in an amount not to exceed \$263,958.00 for completion of the Kampmann Boulevard Preliminary Engineering Report (PER); and authorizes the appropriation of these funds from Bexar County to the Kampmann Boulevard (Babcock Road – Woodlawn Lake) project.
