**SUMMARY:**

Briefing on the Status of Girls in San Antonio Report commissioned by the City of San Antonio.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

In the summer of 2023, the City of San Antonio commissioned a report on the status of girls in San Antonio, in order to establish baseline reporting on issues facing girls.

A full comprehensive report was prepared by Rogelio Sáenz and Christina Quintanilla-Muñoz of the University of Texas at San Antonio, similar to the Status of Women in San Antonio Report which was shared with City Council in May 2019.

This new report on girls and young women in San Antonio utilized a variety of data sources to

provide a detailed account of girls in San Antonio with respect to health and well-being, education, victimization and crime, and demographics and socioeconomic standing. The preliminary results were presented to attendees at the Girls Empowerment Summit in March 2023. The full report and final presentation are now available.

The City plans to renew this report once every five years.
